

IU Northwest CLEP Policy *Effective Spring 2013*

IU Northwest welcomes students from a wide variety of backgrounds and learning experiences. Many students come to our institution with a firm grounding in a particular discipline. CLEP is the most widely accepted credit-by-examination program in the United States, helping students of all ages earn college degrees faster by getting credit for what they already know. While IU Northwest does not administer CLEP exams on campus, we do offer credit and/or advanced placement for several CLEP subject exams.

The following table lists the CLEP subject exams recognized by IU Northwest. Before you register for a CLEP exam, talk to your academic advisor to determine how the credits will apply toward your program of study.
