

IU Post 9/11 Veterans Affairs Yellow Ribbon Program Application AY 2016-2017 Indiana University Northwest will provide up to \$5450 per academic year (\$1362.50 per regular term), based on 30 credit hours for the year), with funds matched by the US Department of Veterans Affairs for up to 6 qualified applicants.

Criteria:

- **Eligible for Ch 33 Post 9/11 Veterans Affairs education benefits at the 100% level**
- **Maintain good academic standing at IU Northwest**
- **Be admitted as a degree-seeking student with tuition and fee charges above the VA's maximum in-state undergraduate rate as posted at www.gibill.va.gov**

If you believe you are eligible, you should apply immediately. Awards to qualified applicants are on a first-come basis established by the date and time your application is received by the Office of the Registrar.

You must provide follow-up documentation of your CH 33 Certificate of Eligibility OR proof of application for CH 33 plus your DD214. We will continue to accept applications until **Friday, October 14, 2016.**

Funds will not be disbursed until our office receives a copy of your Certificate of Eligibility.
