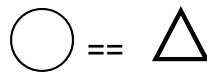
- \_\_\_\_\_ pattern of kinship terms in which members of the nuclear family are distinguished from other relatives of those same generations in a non-unilineal descent society
- \_\_\_\_\_ generational system in which all males in the same generation are called by the same kin term not matter how close or distantly they are related to ego.
- \_\_\_\_\_ systems of kinship terms (such as "Crow" and "Iroquois") in which certain same sex siblings are called by the same term (such as father and father's brother), but a different set of terms is used for relatives in mother's lineage than is used for similar relationships in father's lineage. (Mother's brother is not the same term as father's brother.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ a society in which each child is automatically a member of its father's lineage.
- \_\_\_\_\_ a society in which inheritance passes from a man to his sister's son, not his own son.
