Senior Thesis Exhibition 2008/ 2009

**Portfolio Submission:**

> You must turn in a strong portfolio of 10-20 pieces created within the medium you plan to exhibit for consideration in the Senior Thesis Exhibition during the spring of 2009. A faculty review committee will determine the merit of the work. If the faculty feels your work is **NOT** acceptable, you will be denied enrolling in the (*Spring 2009*) S497 class and you will postpone your senior exhibition until Spring 2010.

> Please take careful consideration of the following items when preparing your portfolio:

: proper, adequate lighting when taking a photograph of the piece

: composition of the piece in the photograph (*i.e. is it straight? other possible angles?*)

: colour quality and accurate representation of the photographed piece

: clean photograph setting/background (*i.e. noise free of other elements in the room such as windows, furniture, people, wallpaper, etc.*)

: image quality and size

> TIP: if you are taking slide or 35mm photographs of your work you can take the roll of film to a store like Wal-Mart (*cheapest place I've found locally*) and ask that they create a CD (digital files) of your slides/photographs.

**Portfolio Submission Guidelines:**

**Acceptable Formats:** CD/DVD or USB flash drive

**File Format:** JPEG (JPG), GIF or TIFF(TIF) files

**Other Formats:** Due to possible conflicts with equipment, hardware, or software please check with your Senior Show Advisor or Kel Knaga about submitting a portfolio in a format other than the ones listed above.

**ALSO:** please include a printed Artist's Statement and list with title, medium and size of each piece included in the portfolio.
