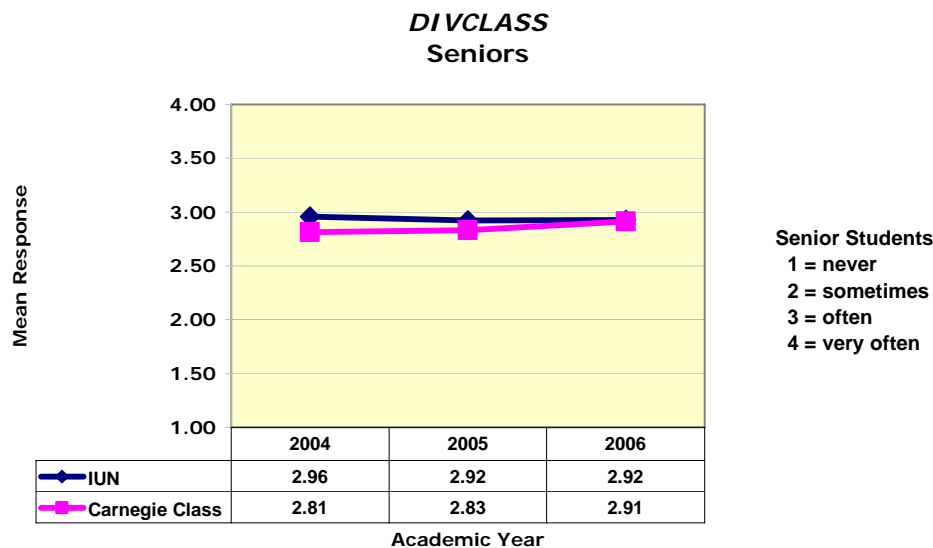
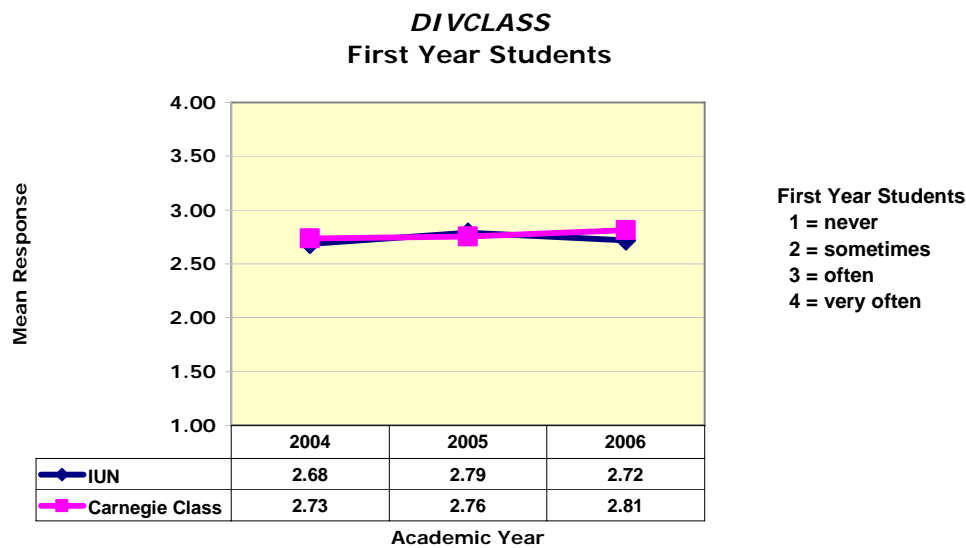

**Included diverse perspectives (different races, religions, genders, political beliefs, etc.) in class discussions or writing assignments**

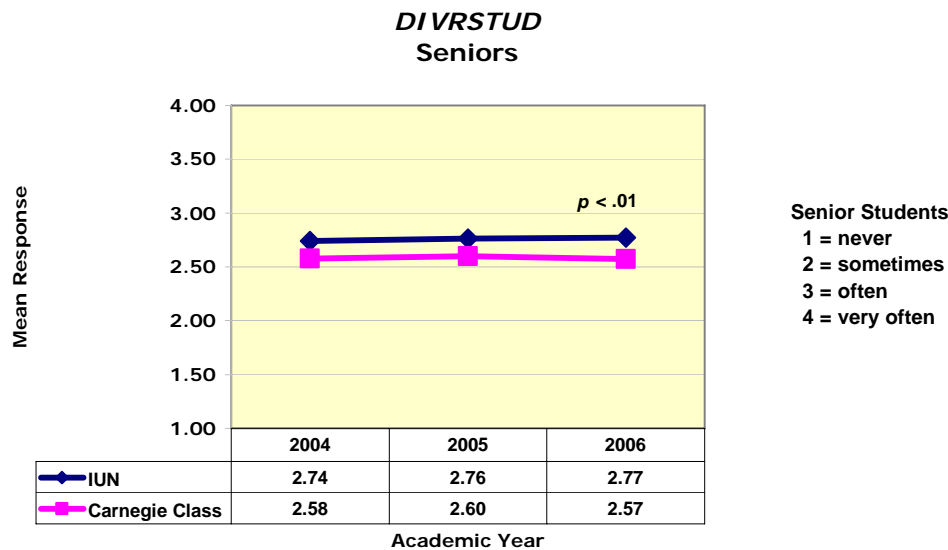
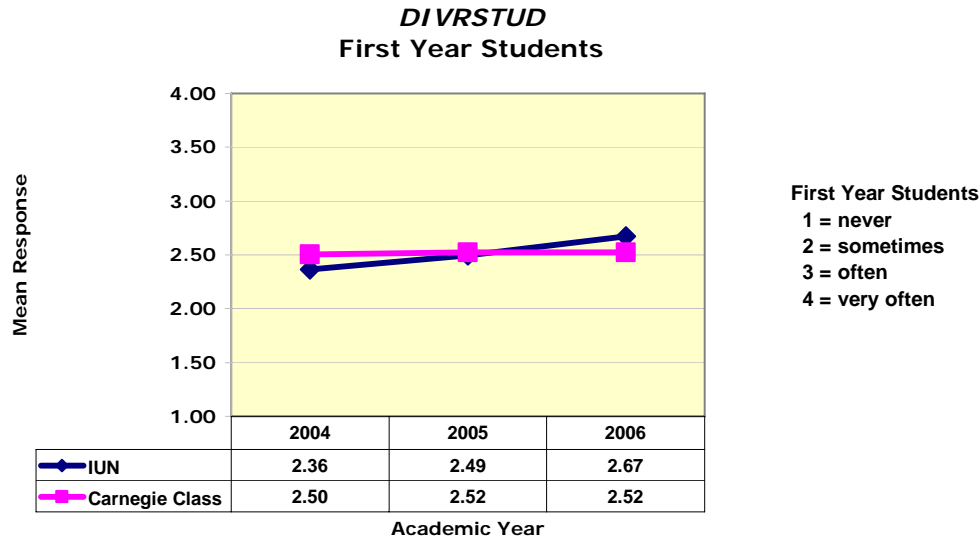

**Had serious conversations with students of a different race or ethnicity than your own**

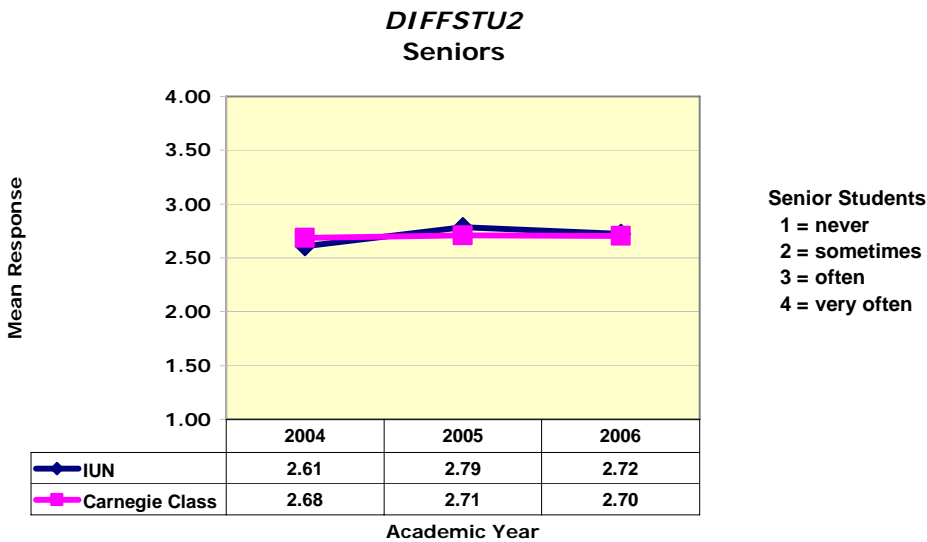
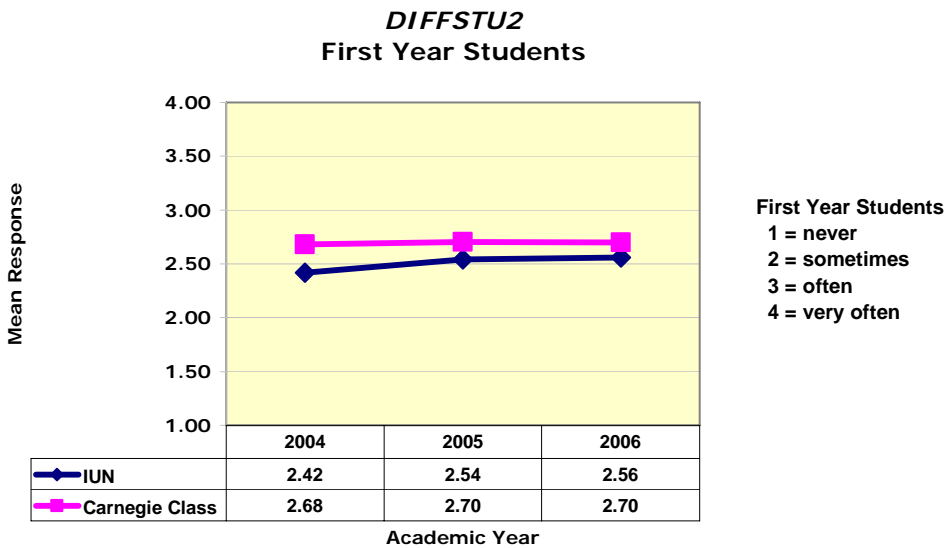

***Had serious conversations with students who are very different from you in terms of their religious beliefs, political opinions, or personal values***



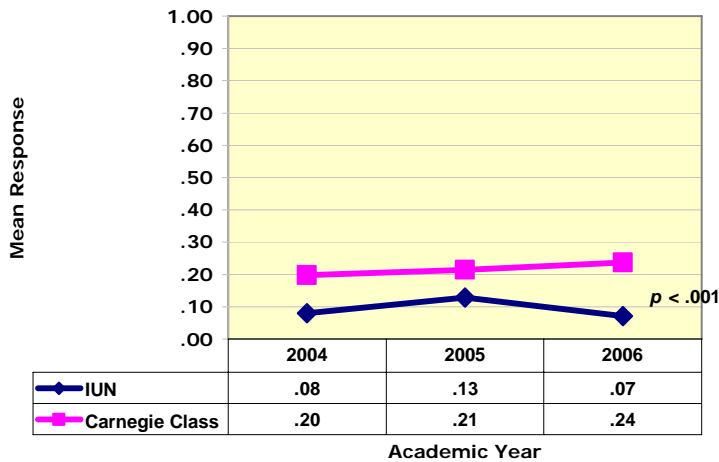

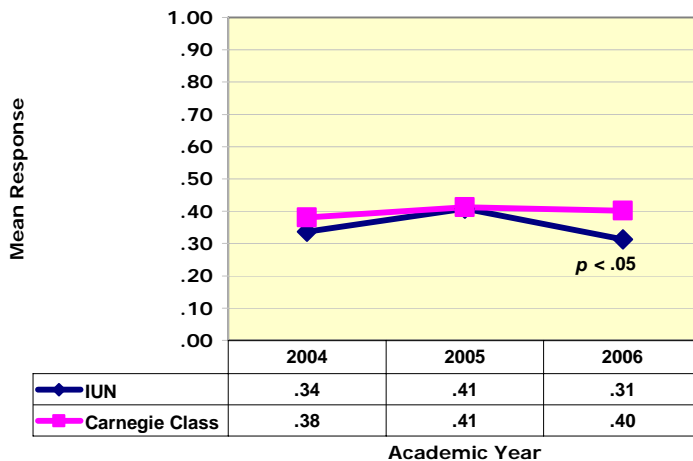

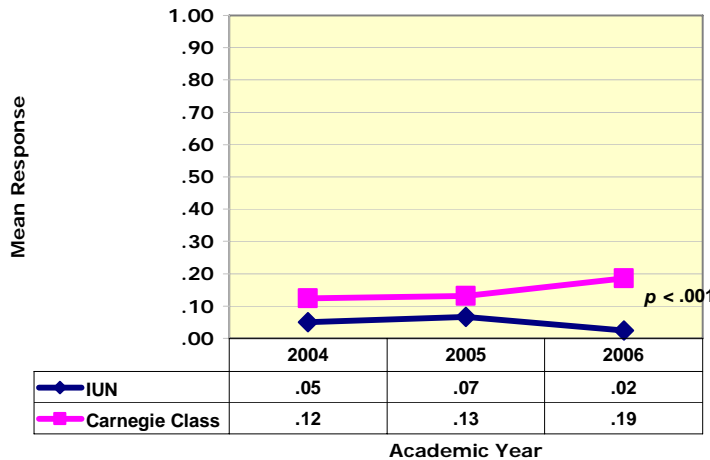

**Encouraging contact among students from different economic, social, and racial backgrounds**

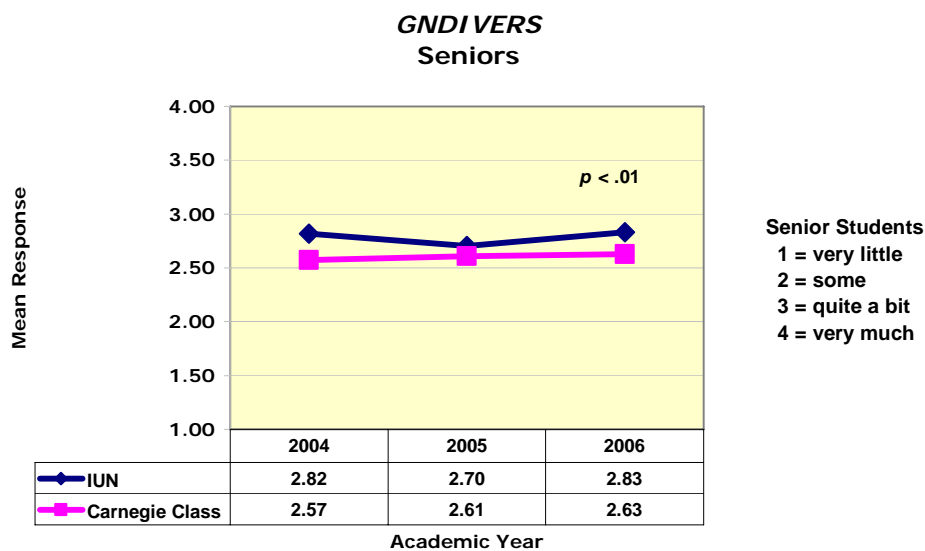
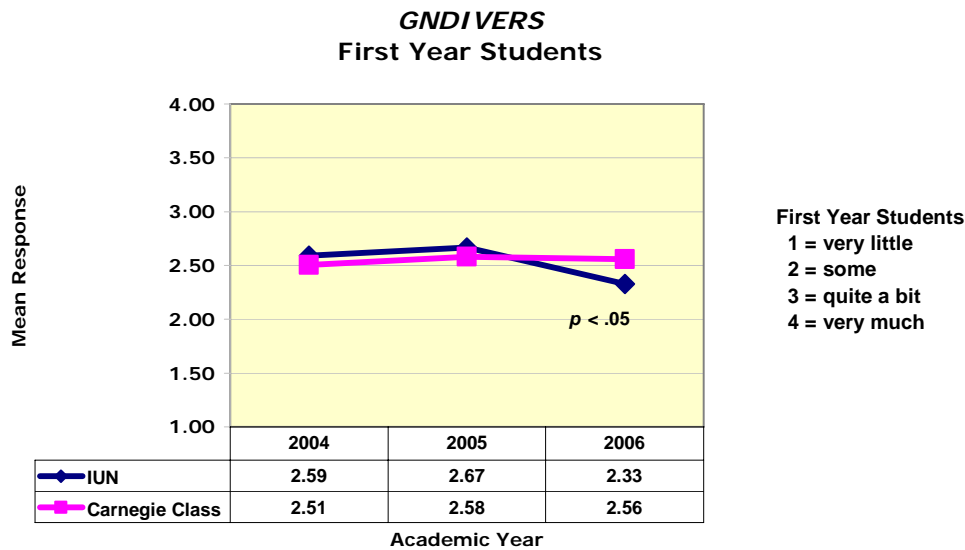
