

Petition to be Reinstated to Major in Arts & Sciences After Dismissal

A first time academically dismissed student from the College of Arts & Sciences will be reinstated, on probation, into the General Studies Program after successfully completing a Reinstatement Workshop. A student may petition to be reinstated into the department of their prior major (eg. English, Chemistry). This form should be submitted to the Dean's office for processing within 7 days (one week) of completing the Workshop. If the petition is accepted, the student will return on probation to his/her prior department. If the petition is denied, the student will be placed in the General Studies Program, where he/she may remain to complete their degree, or, after achieving a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above, the student may select or return to another major.
